



What Is It?

Since 2007, Bob & Mavis have made 4 trips to the region of the U.S. known as the Great Southwest. This 3 ½ hour program tells their story with 1,186 photos and maps in a narrated slide show using 720p HD video. You can watch and listen to their adventures day by day and make your own choices as to the places you will want to see. The program can be downloaded from our website as a set of 14 digital files. .

Your Tour Guide

Carry this program with you on your digital device. There is *no need for Internet access*. You can use it anywhere. You can save \$\$ by touring on your schedule rather than using costly commercial caravans. If you don't own an RV, rent one and use this program to plan your route. Four loops are provided so you can rent and return to the same location

Searchable

The program is divided into four routes; A, B, C and D. Each route has 3 or 4 segments. A complete copy of the 34,000-word narration script is provided as a searchable PDF file. This lets you easily find places of interest and replay that part of the video.

Plays On Digital Devices

The program can be loaded and played on Apple and Windows computers, iPhones, iPads, Android phones and tablets, and digital TVs with USB flash drive inputs. The playing device must support MP4 video.

The Great Southwest

The Southwest area comprises the five states of Utah, Colorado, Arizona, Nevada and New Mexico. This is an incredibly vast and scenic area of deserts and mountains surrounding the Colorado River. It is a sparsely populated area of over 313,000 square miles. The program is not about touring the big cities in the region; it's about visiting the vast spaces between these cities.

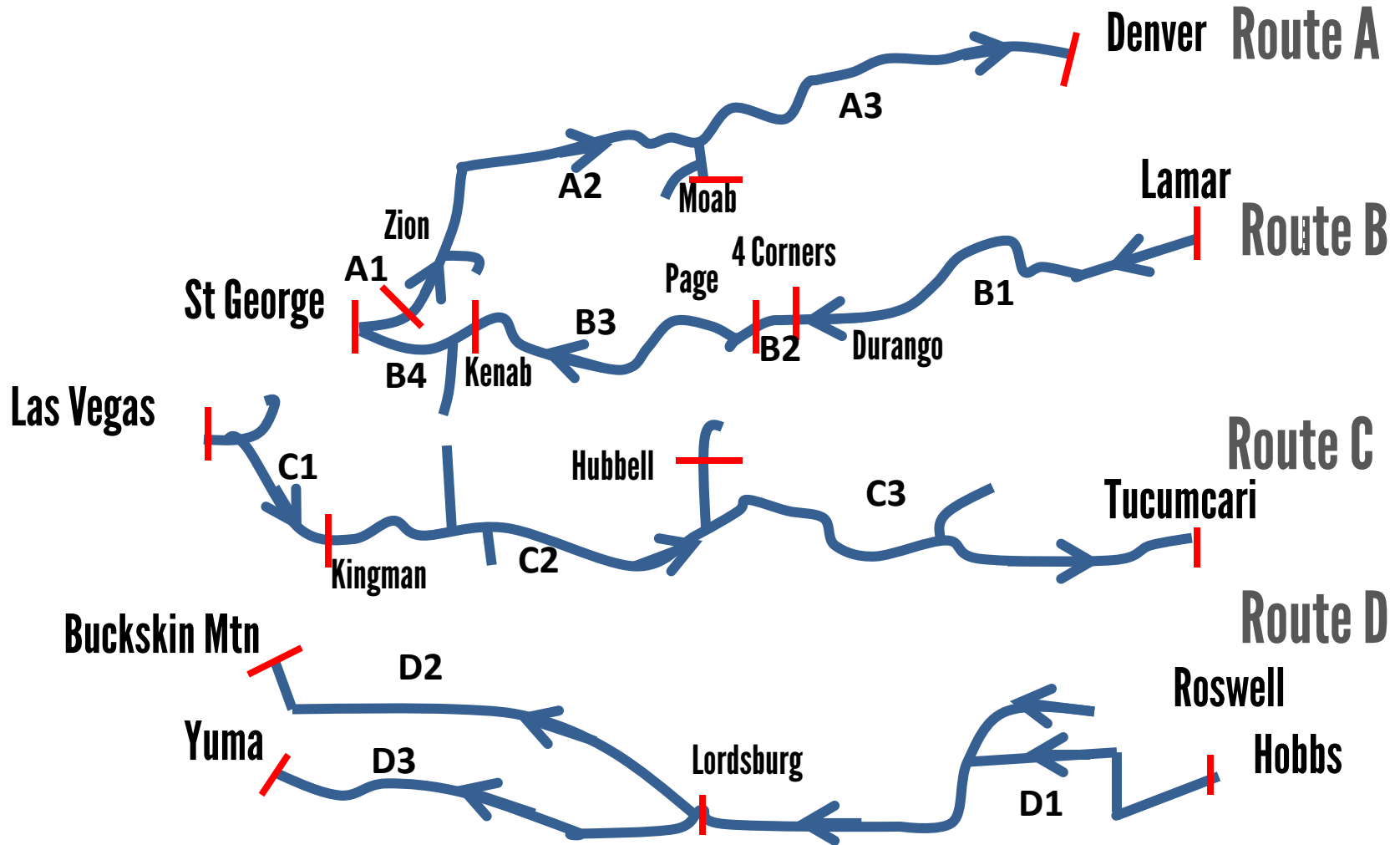

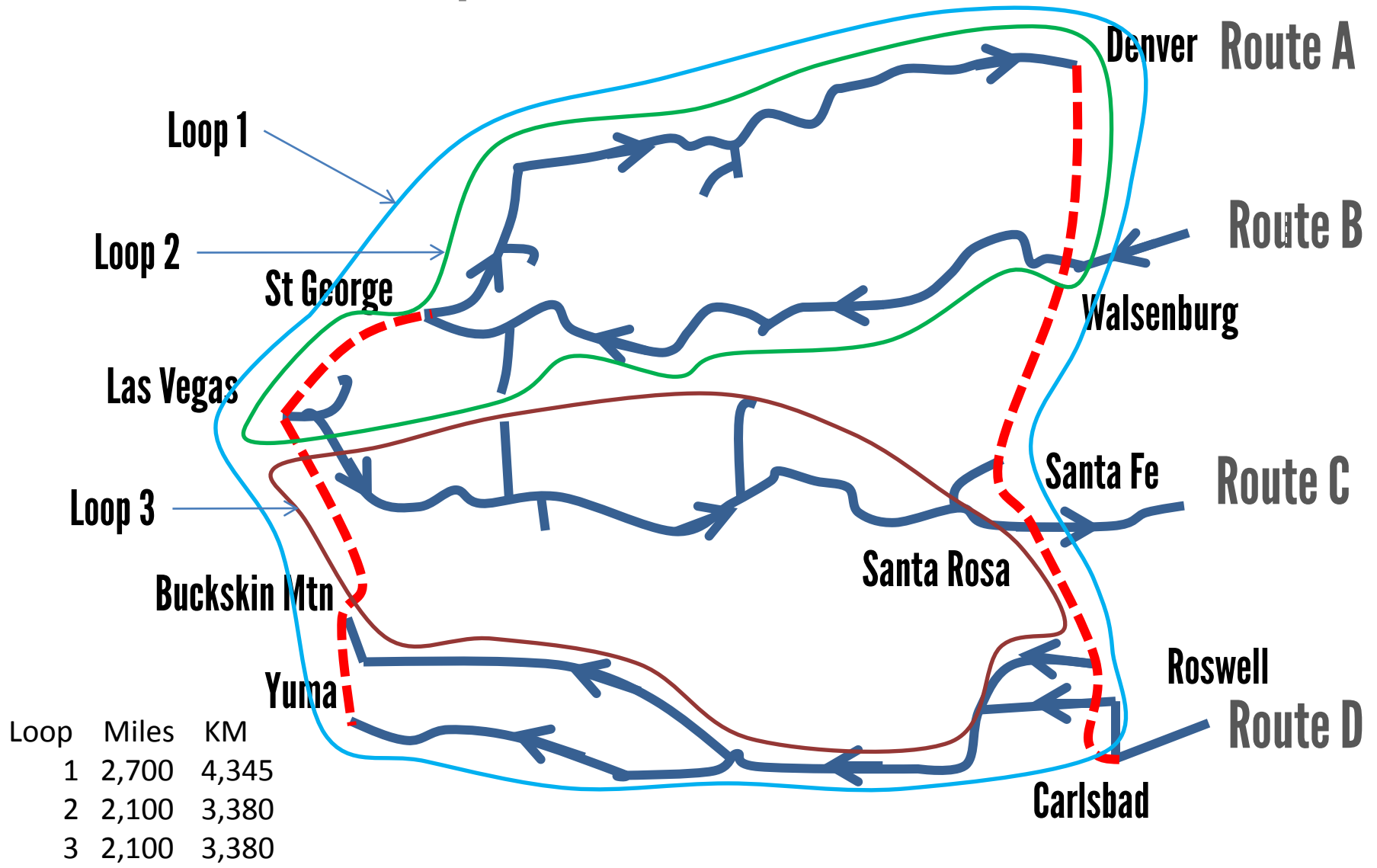
